Our Peer Coaches work with professional staff to use success coaching frameworks and strategies to assist students from an asset-based perspective to reach their unique personal, professional, and academic goals. Peer Coaches are trained using a national model and receive a nationally recognized NASPA Student Leader Certification, and College Reading & Learning Association Certification.

ONBOARDING TRAINING

Peer Coaches participate in a week-long, strengthsbased training program that equips them with the tools and strategies they would need to support students at UC San Diego.

Peer Coaches come together on a biweekly basis for professional development workshops that align with the five domains that guide our learning outcomes, Topics include understanding the first-gen identity, coaching techniques, and civic engagement.
